Create your own Photographic Panorama!

Look closely at Panorama High Street 2012, is this how you would see the street if you were actually there?

Can you spot where the street and buildings don't look how they would in real life?

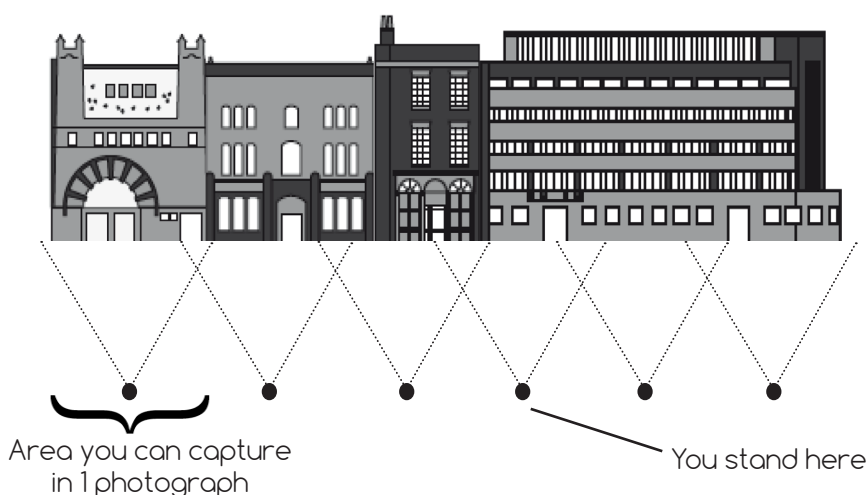
Investigate photographic techniques and the Panorama process, by creating your own Panorama of a street, building, or space near you. It could be in a school playground, or another outdoor space.



Method:

Materials: 1 Camera & a printer

- In teams (we recommend 4-6) stand in a straight line, arms length apart
- Starting at one end of the line, each team member uses the camera to take a photo
- Now pass the camera on to the next person in your line
- Print out your pictures, and arrange them so that they join up



More Ideas

You could experiment with standing at different lengths apart, or in different shapes, other than a line. Why not stand in a circle, facing inwards or outwards.

Experiment taking photos in the same location at different times of the day, or in different seasons. What is the effect on your Panorama?
