Spot it! Shapes and Alphabets

Buildings can be big, small, wide, thin, dominant, pretty, and many other things. Their windows, doors and walls create lots of different shapes.

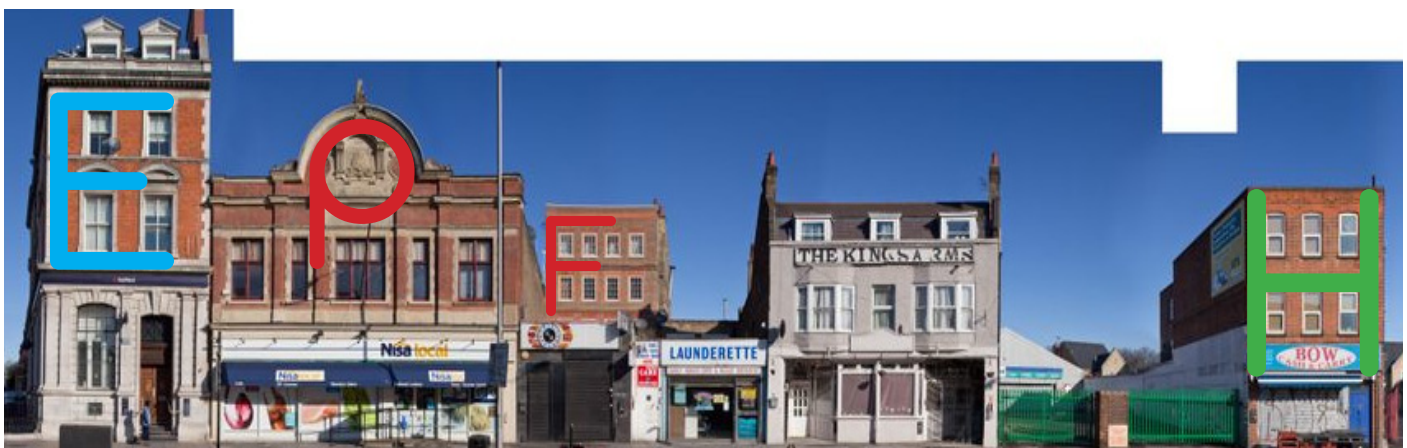

Materials : A camera and a printer

Method :

- Visit High Street 2012 or another street near you, and take photos of the buildings that you see. Start by spotting shapes: triangles, circles, squares or rectangles.
- Then you're home or back in the classroom, print off these images. You could also print images of buildings from the Panorama website.
- Try to identify different letters in the buildings.
- Arrange your letters to create words that describe the high street or the building you have been looking at.
